Where do I place my wheeled Trash container?

- Place your container at your designated collection point before 6:00 a.m. (but no more than 12 hours prior to collection) For Joyce Avenue Homes, Trash collection is in the alley and Recycle collection is on Joyce Avenue (parked cars in the alley prevent recycling trucks from working)
 - \circ Containers must have at least 3 4 feet clearance for the mechanical arm to fit and pick it up
 - If containers are too close together or too close to a parked car, the collection cannot occur. The collection truck driver is not responsible for moving the container for the mechanical arm to pick it up.
 - o If you miss the pickup time, you must move your container back to a secure location and wait until the next week
- Please call the 311 Service Center at (614) 645-3111 if you do not know your designated collection point.
- Remove your container from the collection point no more than 24 hours after collection and keep it in a secure place.

What can I place in the **Trash** container?

- Most of your household trash can be placed in your container.
- Trash must be **bagged and tied** before you place it in your container. This prevents litter and is required by Columbus City Code.
- Do not put trash around the outside of the container. Only trash *inside* the container will be collected.
- Do not overflow the container. Birds and other animals will tear the plastic bags to get into the trash. You may purchase another container if needed... call 311 for more information.

My container is Missing or Damaged

- If your City-provided trash container is missing, stolen, vandalized or defaced, please call the 311 Service Center at (614) 645-3111.
- If your container is damaged in the collection process or from normal wear and tear, please call the 311 Service Center (614) 645-3111. *Please have your serial number ready. It can be located on the side of the container.*
- The container assigned to your address remains the property of the City of Columbus and is printed with the address of the home. If you move, leave the container on the property in a secure place.
